INTRODUCTION TO KALATHON

Kalathon is a dynamic and multifaceted fest that celebrates the diverse talents of K–12 students in sports, culture, arts, crafts, and linguistics. Organized by Mother Teresa Modern Public School, Kurukshetra, Kalathon has been a platform for interschool competitions since its inception in 2022. In its fourth edition, Kalathon 4.0 takes an exciting new leap with the inclusion of Agri-based activities, promoting awareness of sustainability, farming, and environmental responsibility through interactive exhibits. This event encourages participation from both boys and girls across all age groups, offering them a fair and supportive environment to showcase their skills. The competitions are judged by esteemed professionals, ensuring impartiality and high standards. The presence of parents at the event adds to the encouragement and morale of the participants. PREVIOUS RESULTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

In its first year on December 12, 2022, Kalathon attracted 616 students from 29 schools across Kurukshetra district, who competed in 12 events across 22 categories. The event was made even more special by a meet-and-greet with Nicktoons characters Motu Patlu, thanks to the kids' TV partner, NICK. Every participant received a certificate of participation, and 66 achievement certificates, along with trophies and medals, to the top three winners in each category.

The success of the inaugural event paved the way for an expanded Kalathon 2.0, held on October 30, 2023. This edition included participation from 32 schools, with 895 students competing in 18 events across 26 categories. A special appearance by Ninja Hattori, courtesy of Nickelodeon Sonic, added excitement to the event. As before, participation certificates and refreshments were provided to all, and 78 achievement certificates, trophies, and medals were awarded to the best performers.

Kalathon 3.0 was held on December 20, 2024, with participation from 34 schools and 787 students competing in 15 events across 23 categories. Schools were invited to participate and witness the comprehensive development of students in this open and fair platform. As before, participation certificates and refreshments were provided to all, and 69 achievement certificates, trophies, and medals were awarded to the best performers.

Building on this success, Kalathon 4.0 will be organized on October 6, 2025. This edition takes an exciting new leap with the inclusion of Agri-based activities, promoting awareness of sustainability, farming, and environmental responsibility through interactive exhibits. The event will feature a total of 23 events across 38 categories. Out of these, 8 events and 15 categories are dedicated to agricultural activities, encouraging students to engage with nature, sustainability, and hands-on learning.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ There is NO entry fee to participate in the Kalathon.
- ❖ Participants should be the bonafide students of the school that they represent.
- ❖ One student can participate in ONLY ONE event.
- ❖ Students should be accompanied to the venue by the Teacher In-Charge of the participatory school.
- ❖ Participants should reach the venue Mother Teresa Modern Public School, Kurukshetra by 8:30 am on the event day.
- ❖ Participants and Teacher In-Charge must carry their School ID Cards along with them.
- ❖ The Organizing Committee will not be responsible in case the participants reach late and miss out the event.
- ❖ Participants will not be allowed to move out of the venue without the consent of the Teacher In-Charge of the participatory school.
- ❖ Participants are expected to be well disciplined throughout the event. Any kind of indiscipline in any form will be resulted in immediate disqualification from the competition.
- ❖ Decision of jury members will be final and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- ❖ Entry form provided along with the brochure to be used to send the entries. No photocopy to be used. Incomplete forms will be rejected.
- ❖ Total entries for each competition are limited and fixed, entries will be considered on First Come First Serve basis.
- ❖ Each category will be awarded with 3 winners. First (WINNER), Second (FIRST RUNNER UP) and Third (SECOND RUNNER UP).
- ❖ Points will be given to the winners and the school (First Position-15 points, Second Position 10 Points, Third Position-5 points).
- ❖ Overall Rolling Trophy will be awarded to the school with highest points.
- ❖ The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules without information at any point of time

- Performance time: Max 6 to 7 mins.
- Usage of Props is optional.
- Prerecorded music/song to be submitted to the organizers in a pen drive.
- Extra copy to be kept by the Teacher In-Charge.
- Maximum participants: 10 groups.
- Only First 10 groups in each category will be considered for the competition.

- Choreography
- Costume

Type : Group Performance

Category : Junior – Grade 4 to 6
: Senior – Grade 7 to 12

Rules: 

- A School can send only ONE group in the category.
- Group to have 6 to 8 participants.
- Performance time: Max 3 mins.
- Usage of musical instruments/live music is optional.
- Prerecorded music track to be submitted to the organizers in a pen drive. Extra copy to be kept by the Teacher In-Charge.
- Maximum participants: 6 groups.
- Only First 6 groups will be considered for the competition.

04. COSTUME COMPETITION (FANCY DRESS)

'Dress yourself like someone famous character'

Type : Individual Performance Category : Kindergarten – Grade Nursery to Sr. KG
: Sub Junior – Grade 1 to 3



Rules:

- A School can send only ONE entry in the category.
- Performance time 60 seconds.
- Participant can dress himself/herself like a famous character of his/her choice.
- Participant should arrange for his/her own costume and should be ready on time.
- Participant can sing/say dialogue of the character that he/she represents.
- Maximum participants: 10.
- Only First 10 entries will be considered for the competition.

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05. MIME

Showcase your non-verbal communication skills through the art of mime. Use gestures, facial expressions, and body movements to convey stories, emotions and scenarios without using any spoken words.

Type : Group Performance

Category : Senior – Grade 7 to 12



Rules:

- A School can send only ONE group entry in this competition.
- Teams consist of maximum 12 students from the same school.
- Each team performs for 3 minutes.
- Performances should be family-friendly and respectful.
- Teams may choose to use background music or sound effects to enhance their performance, but it should not include any verbal elements. No props, costumes or spoken words allowed.
- Express through gestures, facial expressions and body movements.
- All participants are expected to adhere to a high standard of sportsmanship and respect to fellow participants, judges, and event organizers.
- Only first 10 entries will be considered for competition.

Type : Individual

Category : Senior – Grade 7 to 12



Rules:

- This competition is for individual registration.
- Participants will have a set time limit of 1 hour to complete their face paintings.
- Only safe and eco-friendly paint products are allowed.
- Face painting should be on original creation.
- Face paintings should not include offensive, inappropriate, or culturally sensitive content.
- Self face paint participants will need to present their completed face paintings for judgement.
- Participants are responsible for cleaning up their work area after the competition.
- All participants are expected to adhere to High standard of sportsmanship and respect for fellow participants, judges, and event organizers.

- Theme will be provided at the venue.
- 60 mins will be provided to create the Poster.
- Only 1 white colour A3 Chart Paper will be provided by the organizer at the venue.
- Participants should bring their own colours and other stationery.
- Maximum participants: 50.
- Only first 50 entries will be considered for the competition.

- Each Participant will be given maximum 3 minutes to present his/her views.
- No written script is allowed.
- Maximum participants: 10

- Participants should bring the required material eg: used charts, used crayon, bottle etc. (No new material to be used)
- Max participants - 30.
- Only First 30 entries will be considered for the competition.

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10. FOOTBALL


Type : Team Game

- Only First 8 entries will be considered for the competition.
- Fixtures will be taken 3 days before the event.
- One representative from School needs to present while taking the Fixtures at Mother Teresa Modern Public School - Kurukshetra.





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11. BASKETBALL


Type : Team Game

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12. VOLLEYBALL


Type : Team Game

13. BADMINTON



Type : Doubles

- Only First 10 entries will be considered for the competition.
- If the game is not ended within 15 minutes, Player with Highest points will be declared won.

Type : Team Game

Category : Senior (Boys) - Grade 7 to 9



Rules:

- A School can send only ONE team with 2 players.
- Fixtures will be taken 10 minutes before the start of the game.
- Playing time: 15 mins.
- Maximum participation: 10 Teams.
- Only First 10 entries will be considered for the competition.
- If the game is not ended within 15 minutes, Team with Highest points will be declared won.





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16. Agro-Quiz Competition

Type: Team Participation

Category: Junior - Grade 6 to 8
Sub Senior - Grade 9 to 10
Senior - Grade 11 to 12

Rules: 

- No electronic gadgets allowed.
- Questions will be age-appropriate.
- A school can send only ONE Team with 2 participants in each category.
- Maximum participation : 5 Teams in each category.
- A school can send only 1 entry in each category.

Rules:

- A School can send maximum 2 entries in each category.
- Poster to be made based on the theme provided.
- 60 min. will be provided to create the Poster.
- Only 1 white A3 chart paper will be provided by the organizer at the venue.
- Participants should bring their own color and other stationery.
- Maximum participation 60.

Rules:

- A School can send only ONE group in this category.
- Group consist of maximum 3 members.
- Participant need to bring their own Model.
- Explanation time: maximum 3 minutes to explain their model.
- Maximum entries 10.
- Only first 10 entries will be considered for the competition.

Type : Group Performance

- A school can send only ONE group.
- The team may comprise of either 2 students or 1 student along with teacher / parents.
- Participants need to prepare/assemble this dish during competition without use of fire.
- Participants need to bring their own material.
- Participants need to display their dish along with ingredient list.
- Maximum entries 20.
- Only first 20 entries will be considered for the competition.

Type : Individual Performance Category : Kindergarten - Grade Nursery-UKG
: Sub Junior - Grade 1 to 5

Theme: Know Your Farm



Rules:

- School can send maximum 2 participants in each category.
- Participant can dress like (Farm Product/Farm Animals/Farm Equipment).
- Participant should arrange his/her dress and should be ready on time.
- Participant will be given 1 minute to explain/talk about the dress/theme.
- Maximum 10 entries for each category.
- Only first 20 entries will be considered for the competition.

- Group consist of maximum 10 students from the same school.
- Each group will be given 6 to 8 minutes for performance.
- Performance should be family-friendly and respectful.
- Only first 5 entries will be considered for the competition.

Type : Individual

Category : Junior - Grade 6 to 8

Rules:

- A school can send Maximum 3 participants in this category.
- Only 1 A3 white colour chart paper will be provided.
- Each participant will be given 20 minutes to write a slogan.
- Participants should bring their own colours & other stationery.
- Only first 30 entries will be considered for the competition.

Judgement Criteria:



- Originality -10 marks
- Relevance to Theme - 10 marks
- Language/Poetic Style - 10 marks





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23. Plant-a-Sapling / Fastest Potting Challenge

"Race to Pot, Race to Protect Nature"

Type : Individual

Category : Junior - Grade 6 to 8

: Sub-Senior - Grade 9 to 10

- Participants need to pot a plant correctly with name tag.
