INTRODUCTION TO KALATHON

Kalathon is a dynamic and multifaceted fest that celebrates the diverse talents of K-12 students in sports, culture, arts, crafts, and linguistics. Organized by Mother Teresa Modern Public School, Kurukshetra, Kalathon has been a platform for interschool competitions since its inception in 2022. This event encourages participation from both boys and girls across all age groups, offering them a fair and supportive environment to showcase their skills. The competitions are judged by esteemed professionals from various renowned organizations, ensuring impartiality and high standards. PREVIOUS RESULTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

In its first year on December 12, 2022, Kalathon attracted 616 students from 29 schools across the Kurukshetra district, who competed in 12 events across 22 categories. The event was made even more special by a meet-and-greet with Nicktoons characters Motu Patlu, thanks to the kids' TV partner, NICK. Every participant received a certificate of participation, and 66 achievement certificates, along with trophies and medals, were awarded to the top three winners in each category.

The success of the inaugural event paved the way for an expanded Kalathon 2023, held on October 30, 2023. This edition included participation from 32 schools, with 895 students competing in 18 events across 26 categories. A special appearance by Ninja Hattori, courtesy of Nickelodeon Sonic, added excitement to the event. As before, participation certificates and refreshments were provided to all, and 78 achievement certificates, trophies, and medals were awarded to the best performers.

Kalathon 2024 is scheduled for December 20, 2024, with 15 competitions across 23 categories. Schools are invited to participate and witness the comprehensive development of students in this open and fair platform.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- There is NO entry fee to participate in the Kalathon.
- Participants should be the bonafide students of the school that they represent.
- One student can participate in ONLY ONE event.
- Students should be accompanied to the venue by the Teacher In-Charge of the participatory school.
- Participants should reach the venue Mother Teresa Modern Public School, Kurukshetra by 8:30 am on the event day.
- Participants and Teacher In-Charge must carry their School ID Cards along with them.
- The Organizing Committee will not be responsible in case the participants reach late and miss out the event.
- Participants will not be allowed to move out of the venue without the consent of the Teacher In-Charge of the participatory school.
- Participants are expected to be well disciplined throughout the event. Any kind of indiscipline in any form will be resulted in immediate disqualification from the competition.
- Decision of jury members will be final and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- Entry form provided along with the brochure to be used to send the entries. No photocopy to be used. Incomplete forms will be rejected.
- Total entries for each competition are limited and fixed, entries will be considered on First Come First Serve basis.
- ❖ Each category will be awarded with 3 winners. First (WINNER), Second (FIRST RUNNER UP) and Third (SECOND RUNNER UP).
- Points will be given to the winners and the school (First Position-15 points, Second Position 10 Points, Third Position-5 points).
- Overall Rolling Trophy will be awarded to the school with highest points.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules without information at any point of time

01. SOLO DANCE

'Tap your feet and match the rhythm'

Type: Individual Performance Category: Sub Junior – Grade 1 to 3

: Junior – Grade 4 to 6 : Senior – Grade 7 to 9



- A School can send only ONE entry per category.
- Performance time: Max 3 mins.
- Usage of Props is optional.
- Prerecorded music / song to be submitted to the organizers in a pen drive.

- Extra copy to be kept by the Teacher In-Charge.
- Only first 10 entries in each category will be considered for the competition.







02. GROUP DANCE

'Tap your feet and match the rhythm'

Type: Group Performance Category: Junior – Grade 4 to 6

: Senior – Grade 7 to 12



- A School can send only ONE group in the category.
- Group to have 12 to 20 participants.
- Performance time: Max 6 to 7 mins.
- Usage of Props is optional.
- Prerecorded music/song to be submitted to the organizers in a pen drive.

- Extra copy to be kept by the Teacher In-Charge.
- Maximum participants: 10 groups.
- Only First 10 groups in each category will be considered for the competition.







03. GROUP SINGING

'Set the stage on fire with your melodies'

Type: Group Performance Category: Junior – Grade 4 to 6

: Senior – Grade 7 to 12



Rules:

- A School can send only ONE group in the category.
- Group to have 6 to 8 participants.
- Performance time: Max 3 mins.
- Usage of musical instruments/live music is optional.
- Prerecorded music track to be submitted to the organizers in a pen drive. Extra copy to be kept by the Teacher In-Charge.
- Maximum participants: 6 groups.
- Only First 6 groups will be considered for the competition.

Judgement Criteria:

- Expression
- Chemistry
- Tune
- Rhythm
- Energy







04. COSTUME COMPETITION (FANCY DRESS)

'Dress yourself like someone famous character'

Type: Individual Performance Category: Kindergarten – Grade Nursery to Sr. KG

: Sub Junior – Grade 1 to 3



Rules:

- A School can send only ONE entry in the category.
- Performance time 60 seconds.
- Participant can dress himself/herself like a famous character of his/her choice.
- Participant should arrange for his/her own costume and should be ready on time.
- Participant can sing/say dialogue of the character that he/she represents.
- Maximum participants: 10.
- Only First 10 entries will be considered for the competition.

05. MIME

Showcase your non-verbal communication skills through the art of mime. Use gestures, facial expressions, and body movements to convey stories, emotions and scenarios without using any spoken words.

Type: Group Performance Category: Senior – Grade 7 to 12



Rules:

- A School can send only ONE group entry in this competition.
- Teams consist of maximum 12 students from the same school.
- Each team performs for 3 minutes.
- Performances should be family-friendly and respectful.
- Teams may choose to use background music or sound effects to enhance their performance, but it should not include any verbal elements. No props, costumes or spoken words allowed.

- Express through gestures, facial expressions and body movements.
- All participants are expected to adhere to a high standard of sportsmanship and respect to follow participants, judges, and event organizers.
- Only first 10 entries will be considered for competition.

- Expression
- Teamwork
- Choreography
- Creativity







06. FACE PAINTING

"Brushing Brilliance: Transforming faces into Living Canvases". Unleash your inner artist, blend colours and let your brushstrokes tell a story that resonates on a whole new level. Join us for an event that celebrates the magic of transformation and to showcase the boundless beauty of artistic expression.

Type: Individual Category: Senior – Grade 7 to 12



- This competition is for individual registration.
- Participants will have a set time limit of 1 hour to complete their face paintings.
- Only safe and eco-friendly paint products are allowed.
- Face painting should be on original creation.
- Face paintings should not include offensive, Inappropriate, or culturally sensitive content.

- Self face paint participants will need to present their completed face paintings for judgement.
- Participants are responsible for cleaning up their work area after the competition.
- All participants are expected to adhere to High standard of sportsmanship and respect for fellow participants, judges, and event organizers.







07. POSTER MAKING

'The body achieves what the mind believes'

Fill your thoughts with creativity and colour your imagination. This competition aims to explore students' creative instincts and encourage them to express their ideas.

Type: Individual Performance Category: Junior – Grade 4 to 6

: Senior – Grade 7 to 9



- A School can send maximum 5 entries.
- Poster to be made based on the Theme provided.
- Theme will be provided at the venue.
- 60 mins will be provided to create the Poster.
- Only white colour A4 Chart paper will be provided by the organizer at the venue.

- Participants should bring their own colours and other stationery.
- Maximum participants: 50.
- Only first 50 entries will be considered for the competition.

Type: Individual Performance Category: Senior – Hindi – Grade 7 to 9

: Senior – English – Grade 7 to 9

Topic for the Debate: "Is social media boon or bane?"



- A School can send only ONE entry in the category.
- Participant should speak either in favour / against the given topic.
- Each Participant will be given maximum 3 minutes to present his/her views.
- No written script is allowed.
- Maximum participants: 10
- Only First 10 entries will be considered for the competition.







09. BEST OUT OF WASTE

'When you refuse to re-use, It is the earth you abuse'

Make something innovative and attractive out of the material that is of no use otherwise. This competition aims at igniting creativity among the students. An attempt to make Something from Nothing.

Type: Individual Performance Category: Junior – Grade 4 to 6

: Senior – Grade 7 to 9



- A School can send maximum 3 entries in the category.
- Only 60 mins. will be provided to create Best Out of Waste.
- No Material will be provided by the organizers at the venue.

- Participants should bring the required material eg: used charts, used crayon, bottle etc. (No new material to be used)
- Max participants 30.
- Only First 30 entries will be considered for the competition.

10. FOOTBALL

Type: Team Game Category: Senior - Boys - Grade 7 to 9



- A School can send only ONE team.
- Team should have 11 + 4 players.
- All players should wear appropriate Team uniform [Jersey] with Numbers printed on it.
- All players should wear appropriate shoes. Playing time: 20 mins [10 mins a side].

- Maximum participation: 8 Teams.
- Only First 8 entries will be considered for the competition.
- Fixtures will be taken 3 days before the event.
- One representative from School needs to present while taking the Fixtures at Mother Teresa Modern Public School - Kurukshetra.







11. BASKETBALL

Type: Team Game Category: Senior – Girls – Grade 7 to 9



- A School can send only ONE team.
- Team should have 7-12 players.
- All players should wear appropriate Team uniform [Jersey] with Numbers printed on it.
- All players should wear appropriate shoes.
- Playing time: 20 mins [10 mins a side].

- Maximum participation: 4 Teams.
- Only First 4 entries will be considered for the competition.
- Fixtures will be taken 3 days before the event.
- One representative from School needs to present while taking the Fixtures at Mother Teresa Modern Public School -Kurukshetra.







12. VOLLEYBALL

Type: Team Game Category: Senior – Boys - Grade 7 to 9



- A School can send only ONE team.
- Team should have 7-12 players.
- All players should wear appropriate Team uniform [Jersey] with Numbers printed on it.
- All players should wear appropriate shoes.
- Points/Score based game, Team with highest points will be declared won.
- Maximum participation: 4 Teams.

- Only First 4 entries will be considered for the competition.
- Fixtures will be taken 3 days before the event.
- One representative from School needs to present while taking the Fixtures at Mother Teresa Modern Public School, Kurukshetra.







13. BADMINTON

Type: Doubles Category: Senior – Girls – Grade 7 to 9



- A School can send only ONE team.
- Team should have 2 players.
- All players should wear appropriate Team uniform [Jersey] with Numbers printed on it.
- All players should wear appropriate shoes.
- Players should bring their own rackets.
- Points/Score based game. Team with highest points will be declared won.

- Maximum participation: 4 Teams.
- Only First 4 entries will be considered for the competition.
- Fixtures will be taken 3 days before the event.
- One representative from school needs to present while taking the fixtures at Mother Teresa Modern Public School, Kurukshetra.







14. CHESS

'Let's move every step cautiously'

Type: Individual Category: Senior – Girls - Grade 7 to 9



- A School can send only ONE entry •
- Fixtures will be taken 10 minutes before the start of the game.
- Playing time: 15 mins.

- Maximum participation: 10.
- Only First 10 entries will be considered for the competition.
- If the game is not ended within 15 minutes, Player with Highest points will be declared won.










15. CARROM
